#### Abstracts and Biographical Notes

Now that the Program Committee has accepted your conference proposal, you are required to enter your abstract online in the GreyGuide Repository on or before **May 10, 2019**. If your biographical note is not yet in the GreyGuide, please also submit it by that same date. Simply click, <http://greyguiderep.isti.cnr.it/userarea.php?langver=en>, select **GLA: Conference Abstract** and complete the online template. Then select **BIO: Who is in Grey Literature** and complete the online template.

#### Guidelines for Presentations

You will have **20 minutes** for your presentation, excluding Q&A. If you are planning to use **PowerPoint**, the maximum number for any given presentation is **12 slides** and the **minimum font size is 20**. The due date for receipt of your PowerPoint file is **September 25, 2019**. PowerPoint slides received after this date will not be printed in the GL21 Program Book. Please bring a backup with you on a USB stick. Before your Session begins, present a note to the Day Moderator with at least one critical question pertaining to your paper that can be used during the Q&A and subsequent discussion.

#### Guidelines for full text Papers and accompanying Research Data

Manuscripts should not exceed 20 double-spaced pages. The size of the page can be either A-4 or 8½x11 inches. Provide also the title, author(s) and affiliation(s) followed by your abstract, etc. Credit all source material in your bibliography, references, and/or endnotes. A copy of your full text paper should arrive at the office of TextRelease on or before **October 15, 2019** and a corresponding PDF or print-out should accompany the Word file by that same date. Both text and graphics are required in black and white for publication in the GL20 Conference Proceedings. Your research data is likewise requested and will be entered in the DANS Data Archive. For examples, click-on <https://easy.dans.knaw.nl/ui/home> and enter '**greynet**' in the search box.
