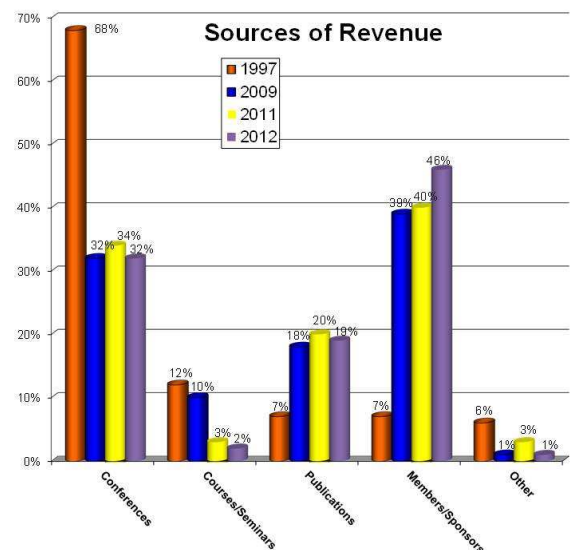
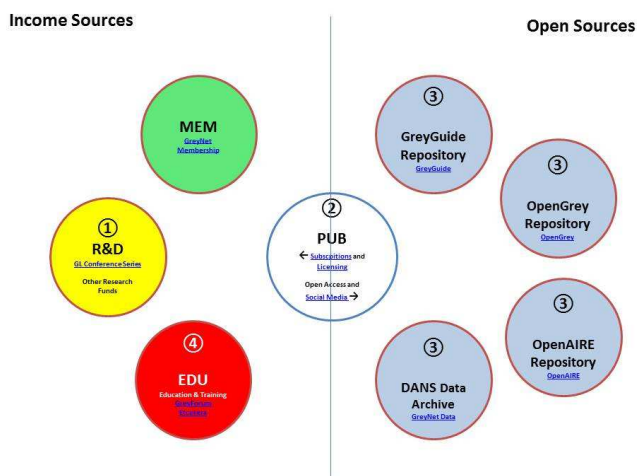


# GreyNet International: A New Infrastructure in 2014
