### A Community Driven Open Resource Project in Grey Literature

The GreyGuide - Repository and Guide to Good Practices and Resources in Grey Literature was launched in 2013 as a collaborative effort between GreyNet International and ISTI-CNR.

GreyGuide aims at

- Offering information professionals, practitioners, and students common ground for good practices and resources in grey literature;
- Providing support for all stakeholders working on Grey Literature related research issues;
- Being consistent with recommendations made in the Pisa Declaration on Policy Development for Grey Literature Resources as well as Open Science guiding principles.



This year activities dealing with the GreyGuide have focused on developing a new version of its Portal and designing a **thematic repository**. The focus is geared to 'Open Access Knowledge', which includes aspects of Open Access, Open Data, and Open Source. In brief, it adheres to an Open Science Vision.

Two new open access sections have been added to the Portal in an effort to make available diverse types of documents, namely:

- ✓ Slides Presentations, Conference Proceedings, Program books, GreyNet In-house Publications, Info Adverts; and
- ✓ Training materials.
