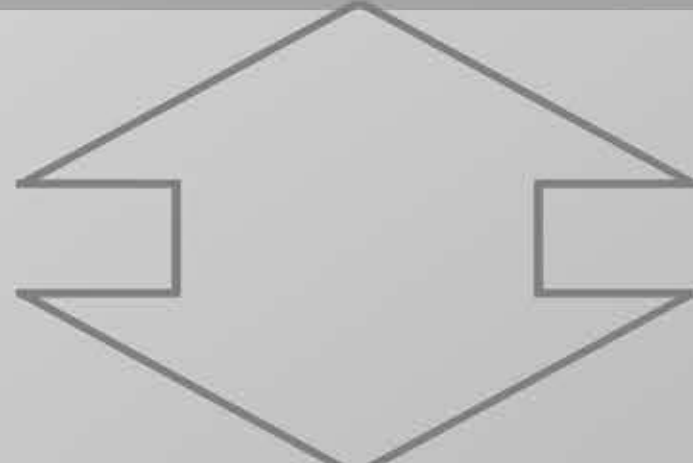

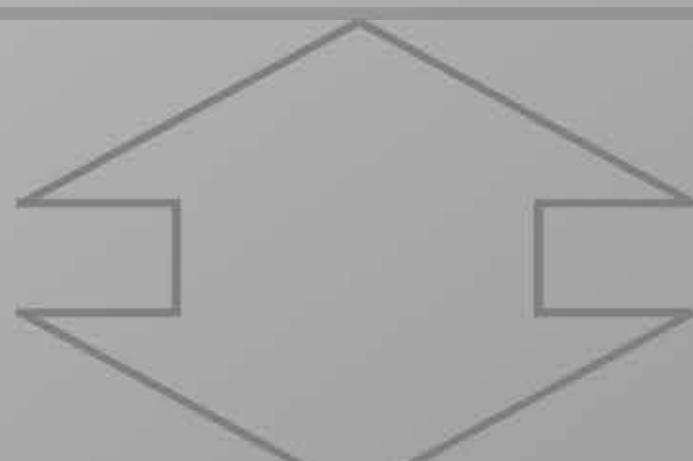

Hurricane Katrina has inspired a huge amount of research, much of which has been written from either a policy or hazard/disaster perspective. Similarly, I propose in Chapter 3 that economic analyses of pre-and post-Katrina data must be contextualized by the post-Katrina
