- diffuse its scientific results

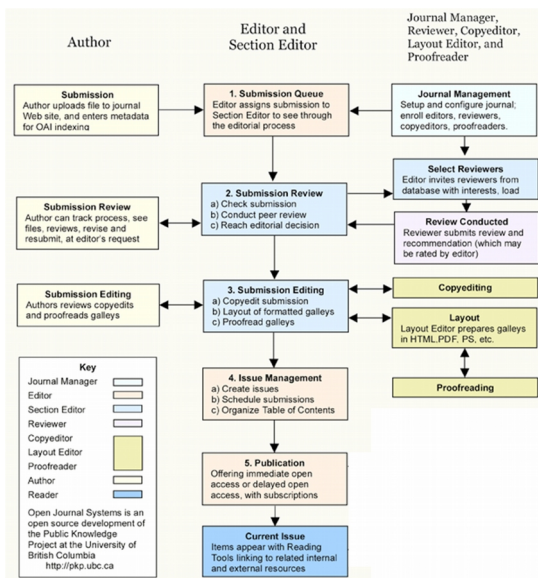
