- Not published by commercial publishers
- May include copyrighted material and may not be completely public domain
- Selected, processed, indexed, and distributed



DTIC Methodology

- Provides, maintains, and applies controlled vocabulary: DTIC Thesaurus
- Groups corporate authors/ organizations hierarchically
- Organizes content by broad subject areas
 - DTIC Subject Categories: 25 broad subject fields and 251 groups
 - Alphabetical Index to the SCG
 - Numeric Index to the SCG


