

- Produced non-commercially



Yizkor (memorial) books are a crucial source for research in East European Jewish history, Holocaust studies, and Jewish genealogy. Written in Yiddish or Hebrew or both, most titles include extensive documentation of Jewish life before the War, followed by vivid, first-hand accounts of the Holocaust and its aftermath. Visually, most of the books are extremely rich, featuring detailed maps, photographs and illustrations. Many titles include necrologies – lists of those who died – which mak these books especially valuable for genealogical research.

Most yizkor books were printed by small associations and committees of survivors, primarily for their own use. As a result, p runs were small, and copies have been extremely hard to find. This reprint project marks the first time they are systematicall available from a single source.






